When I open my palms to the sky



- Arrival at Cairo International Airport
- ♣ Transfer to Your Accommodation hotel in Cairo by a Private Air Conditioned Vehicle.
- Overnight in Cairo
- → Upon arrival to Cairo International Airport, you will be met with our English-speaking representative who will help and assist you in all formalities including getting the Entry Visa and bags assistance .
- → Then transfer you to your hotel for check in and overnight in Cairo.
- → Our travel manager will welcome you upon arrival to the hotel , he will assist you in all the check in procedures and make sure that you have a smooth arrival
- → Welcome meeting (with fresh welcome drink) will be hold at your hotel lobby where our tour manager will revise with you all the details of the trip and confirm the timing of the daily tours.

Day 03: Private Opening for the Great Pyramids & Sphinx - Luxor Overnight

- Private opening & entrance of the Great Pyramids
- Visit the Great Pyramids.
- Transfer back to your accommodation hotel .
- Breakfast at the hotel
- → Pickup from your hotel in Cairo at 3.00 A.M
- → Transfer to the great pyramids plateau for PRIVATE OPENING and ENTRANCE of the Pyramids.
- → Then you will be met by our English Egyptologist tour guide to start your day tour by visiting Pyramids of Giza "Khufu, Khafre & Menkaure, where the greatness has been embodied in three pyramids with a limestone statue of Sphinx guarding the whole area.
- → Constructed between 2589 and 2504 B.C., the Egyptian pyramids of Khufu, Khafre and Menkaure, built in that order, are a testament to ancient planning and engineering.
- → Despite the differences among the three pyramids (Khufu's pyramid, the "Great Pyramid," is several times the mass of Menkaure's) the southeast tips of each pyramid align together almost precisely. Each pyramid had a mortuary and valley temple, with a causeway connecting them. They also had smaller pyramids referred to as satellite or queens' pyramids.
- → The Sphinx, an enigmatic monument usually associated with king Khafre, stands watch near his valley temple. In addition, tombs sprawling to the east and west of Khufu's pyramid contain the remains of officials, royal relatives and others who had the privilege to be buried there











- Breakfast at your accommodation hotel in Cairo (All the Group)

- Lunch in a local restaurant in Cairo
- ♣ Transfer to Cairo airport and fly to Luxor
- ♣ Arrival to Luxor and transfer to the accommodation hotel in Luxor
- → Breakfast at your accommodation hotel in Cairo and check out.
- → After that you will proceed to the city of Sakkara, where you will be so excited by exploring The Step Pyramid of king Djoser. This pyramid has a very nice story, when king Djoser asked his chief Architect Imhotep to create something different, so that the king could be buried at. As a result the well-known Architect creates the Step pyramid, which surprised the king so much since it was considered to be a new achievement in this period.
- → Finally we will drive towards Memphis, where you can visit <u>The Open Air Museum</u> including the marvelous monuments of king Ramses II.
- → Lunch will be in a local restaurant in Cairo.
- → After finishing your day tour, you will be transferred to Cairo airport to fly to Luxor.

❖ Day 04: Private Opening to Danderah Temple - Visit Abydous - Luxor Overnight

- ♣ Breakfast box from your hotel in Luxor
- Private Opening to Danderah temple
- Visit Abydous
- Lunch in a local restaurant
- Transfer back to your accommodation hotel in Luxor and overnight.
- → Breakfast boxes from your hotel in Luxor.
- → Then continue to <u>Dendera</u> to visit the Temple of Hathor, goddess of love and joy. The temple is located in Dendera which is situated at the north of Luxor
- → Then visit Abydos, the ancient Egyptian believed of God (Lord of the underworld) to be buried there. The temple was built by King Seti I, and completed by King Ramsess II, known as the temple of Seti I. It is located in Abydos city about 420 km to the south of Cairo in Sohag Government, and 135 km from Luxor. The paintings of the Gods and Pharaohs on the walls of the Osiris Temple at Abydos are among the most beautifully preserved in Egypt.
- → Lunch will be in a local restaurant.
- → After finishing the full day tour , you will be transferred back to Luxor and overnight in your accommodation hotel in Luxor.

❖ Day 05 : - Private Karnak Temple Visit - Visit Luxor Temple - Nile Cruise Overnight.

- **↓** Visit Karnak Temple PRIVATE OPENING at 3.00 A.M
- Transfer back to the hotel.
- Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
- Transfer to the Nile Cruise
- ♣ Embarkation on the cruise and check in
- Lunch on the Cruise
- ♣ Afternoon visit to Luxor Temple
- → Private opening of the Karnak Temple at 3.00 A.M.
- → you will discover the East bank of Luxor including <u>Karnak Temples Complex</u>, which are the largest structures ever build in the history of the mankind. The principal building is that of god Amun Ra, since it was considered the house of god on the earth, the earlier structure date back to the middle kingdom, but there are some references which refer to the earlier buildings as old as the 3rd dynasty.







- → Breakfast will be at your hotel in Luxor.
- → Check out from the hotel at 11.30 A.M and being transferred to your Nile Cruise for embarkation and check in
- → Lunch on the Cruise .
- → Later on, you will proceed to visit <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, which was built by one of the kings of the 12th dynasty and completed by the well know king Ramses II. This temple was located in the heart of ancient Thebes and, like Karnak, was dedicated to the main/chief god Amun Re.
- → After finishing your day tour , you will be transferred to the Nile Cruise


❖ Day 06: Luxor West Bank - Sail to Esna - Nile Cruise Overnight.

- → At the end of the tour you will visit <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which is belonging to king Amenhotep III. After that you will return to your ship to have your lunch.


